






(IS THE BABY WATER OR BLOOD?)



With a heavy heart, the young woman shared they just wanted pills to make the problem-pregnancy go away. They had plans to marry but the "bride-price" to be paid to the young woman's family back in Africa had not yet been set and with the news of an impending pregnancy all "sale transactions" between the families would likely be halted. The shame and societal pressure was too heavy

for either to bear; they felt there was no option but termination of the pregnancy.

It was quickly clarified that the Choices Medical Services clinics do not provide nor refer for abortions,

but, we could provide some necessary medical services, including an ultrasound. She looked carefully at the image on the ultrasound screen. Life was undeniable – the heartbeat was both seen and heard.

At the same time, her partner's advocate was able to use a translation app on his phone to ascertain that the couple adhered to the Islamic faith and believed from the Quran that the pre-born would not have life until 40 to 120 days after conception - when the breath of Allah entered the womb. If they waited to terminate the child after that time then they would not go to "paradise."

As the couple discussed the ultrasound images, the young woman very emphatically asked the question, "Mtoto ni Maji au damu?" (Is the baby water or blood?) I carefully explained that for the heart to beat there must be blood but, by God's design, the baby is placed in a cloud of water within the mother for protection and thus, the baby was in fact both water and blood. This meant, in their culture, that the baby was recognized as full of life.

The young woman stated with conviction that they would not abort their child. She said:

"IT MUST BE GOD'S WILL."

I pray that the gift of an ultrasound to this couple from afar will go on to provide the opportunity for living water to another person, tribe or nation in the world.





By now most of you have been introduced to LifeChoices' mobile medical unit, which our staff lovingly dubbed "Josh." As Josh was built to specifications last year our team received updates on his *development* during the planning phase, his *formation* during the outfitting process and then, with great anticipation, we awaited his *arrival*. We were as excited as any proud parent would be as Josh made his *debut* at LifeChoices' annual banquet last September.

Well, as any family will tell you, time goes by way too quickly and our little Josh is already going to college!

Josh is traveling to a local college once a week to provide free medical services. This college has no medical clinic on campus and has a high population of both domestic and international students that could benefit from LifeChoices' sexual health services. We are excited to see how many individuals will be served on the mobile unit, once everyone meets the new freshman on campus.

In addition to attending college, Josh will be **working** a second day each week by going to various other locations. He has just recently been approved to serve at a community center in one of our neighboring border states – taking our services where they've never been.


LINKS FOR LIFE 2016
