

Seeing the heartbeat of her son was overwhelming. She was instantly convicted to get a grip on her substance abuse and start a new life for herself and her child. The father of the baby stood in shock as the evidence of life was undeniable.

Both grandmothers of this little one were present in the ultrasound room, and one turned to me, eyes glistening with tears, and shared,

"Over 20 years ago I came here when I had nowhere to go. This is my baby boy all grown up. Without LifeChoices he wouldn't be here today and I wouldn't get the chance to feel the excitement I have right now of becoming a grandma."

CHOICES

Human trafficking is one of the fastest growing criminal practices in the world today. According to the Southwest Missouri Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, there were **571** cases involving child sexual exploitation/human trafficking in our region in 2018. We can no longer blindly deny the existence of human trafficking in our backyard.

For over 30 years, LifeChoices has been a strong voice for the voiceless and defender of life. Since 2016, we have been expanding our mission to include prevention education about this rising danger to our local children, and serving firsthand with medical services for those suffering from the effects of modern day slavery. In conjunction with the local coalition against trafficking, our Victims Response Team has responded to local, state, and federal requests for assistance with 12 human trafficking operations. Since launching this outreach initiative, LifeChoices has served over 101 survivors of trafficking and exploitation!

The compassionate and professional response behind the innovative implementation of our mobile medical unit has allowed for partnerships with other domestic trafficking organizations, and has led to collaborative efforts to make a difference locally, throughout our state, and Nation-wide. We are honored to serve on the Missouri Attorney General's task force against trafficking, and to be members of the coalition against trafficking serving the US Prosecuting Attorney in the Western District of Missouri. Because of your support, our traction and impact in southwest Missouri has been phenomenal and is now being documented as a template for action in other regions of our Nation!

We dare to step into new areas to serve the most vulnerable because we believe in the value of all life, whether that is of a tiny baby in the womb, or a woman exploited in her own neighborhood.

A TIPTOE AND A WHISPER

Sometimes it takes a client tiptoeing in for our services to fully realize what she needs. And, often, it's the whispers that we say consistently over several appointments that eventually add up to a bigger moment. Here are Carrie's* tiptoes and the whispers she received, which made all the difference.

We first met Carrie on our mobile medical unit. She was a college student and it was apparent that she was driven and kind. As many do, Carrie had bought into the idea that part of the "college experience" was casual hook-ups, and so she wanted to be tested "just to be sure". That first appointment was brief, but the whispers of acceptance, encouragement and love she received had her walking back onto the mobile unit a few months later...

Her second visit was longer and she shared a little more. She shared her dreams of the future and the promising career path she had in front of her. She shared about her friendships on campus, as well as her supportive family at home. Our team encouraged her to stay on a path that would allow her to achieve her goals, to meet a man that would respect her, and to know a God that loves her deeply.

Carrie's third visit was full of laughter and catching up on what she had done in the months between appointments. She had attended church with her family and worked hard at her job. She had returned to campus to finish her degree and, in the midst of that, she had re-kindled a relationship with another student. She didn't know if he had other partners, and she wasn't sure where their relationship was headed. While samples were taken for testing, the staff again whispered to her that she deserved a relationship with a man that truly cared for her.

Carrie's fourth visit was defined by tension and nervousness. She had missed her period and thought she might be pregnant. She knew immediately where to go; Carrie came straight to our mobile unit, tearful and anxious. When the pregnancy test was positive and an ultrasound was offered, our team helped Carrie convince her partner to come see the images. The staff whispered support and encouragement to them, and

the appointment ended with an opportunity to pray with them as they contemplated their options.

When Carrie returned for her next appointment, she was more grounded and sure of her decision.

THINGS WERE NOT PERFECT, BUT SHE KNEW SHE WAS GOING TO BE FINE.

Her partner had decided that abortion was their best option and wanted her to terminate: Carrie swiftly told him that abortion was not an option for her and she would have this baby with or without him. She had talked to her parents about the pregnancy and they were passionately supportive of Carrie and her baby. With the support of her family, she was beginning to see a way that she could have this baby and still graduate and complete the career goals she had in mind. At the end of her appointment, Carrie confidently took the pictures of her baby and asked for our team to pray with her.

A tiptoe onto the mobile unit and repeated whispers of encouragement from our team had prepared Carrie for this moment. We never know the seeds that we plant during those hard visits with clients that seem disconnected and distant from reality,

The opportunity to go into schools and teach students biblically-based principles about relationships is not an opportunity that we take lightly. We are proud to present three different and unique programs in 16 area school districts! Last year alone we educated almost 10,000 students!

Kristin, one of our Project ID presenters, recently spent a day guiding 5th and 6th grade students to think critically about their futures, equipping them with tools and practical exercises:

"Every time we make a choice - big or small - what happens afterwards?" Kristin asked a class of 5th grade students. "Consequences!" one student shouted with a hand raised. "Absolutely! And sometimes we make a choice that has negative consequences, maybe because your friend pressured you or you listened to something on the internet, but ultimately who is responsible for the choices that you make and the outcome of those

choices?" "ME!" the class unanimously shouted.

It is truly amazing to watch children put the building blocks of healthy decision making together on their own. We believe in the strength and power of our youth, and we are honored to walk alongside them as they make important decisions impacting their futures.

In Project ID, we spend five days with students talking about healthy decision making in areas relating to taking care of their bodies, discerning between a real or toxic friend, and how to set boundaries for the internet. In Compass, our 7th, 8th, and 9th grade program, we expand on those critical thinking skills by challenging what students believe about dating and their behaviors online. We present medically accurate information about puberty, reproduction, and STIs, and we lead in-depth discussions on topics such as cyber safety, the harm of pornography, and healthy relationships. Every day we encourage discussions between students and their parents, creating a bridge that allows parents to speak to the values important to their family.

We strive to create a fun and safe environment for students to explore complicated topics. One student recently shared, "It was an amazing experience. I learned a lot of stuff and I now know the hazards of sex. Compass kind of made a better relationship between me and my parents so I can talk to them more. Thank you."

It is one of our greatest privileges to speak into the lives of the teens in our communities. Thank you for your support of these important programs!
