# WITH SPECIAL GUEST TIM TEBOW

Tim is a two-time national champion, first round NFL draft pick and Heisman Trophy winner. In addition, he serves as a college football analyst for ESPN. Prior to joining ESPN Tebow played three years in the NFL for the Denver Broncos and the New York Jets. Currently, Tebow is pursuing a career in professional baseball as a member of the New York Mets organization.

Tebow is the author of two New York Times Best Selling books; Through My Eyes, which was named the #1 sports and religion book of 2011 and Shaken: "Discovering your True Identity in the Midst of Life's Storms" which released in 2016 and won the 2017 Evangelical Christian Publishers Association Book of the Year. Tebow released his third New York Time best seller, This Is The Day, on September 25, 2018.

Tim Tebow grew up the son of missionaries and has returned to the Philippines several times throughout his life to spread God's word, and do the Lord's work by serving the needy.

The Tim Tebow Foundation was established in 2010 with the goal to bring faith, hope and love to those needing a brighter day in their darkest hour of need. The foundation fulfills this mission every day by making dreams come true for children with lifethreatening illnesses, building Timmy's Playrooms in children's hospitals, providing life-changing surgeries to children of the Philippines through the Tebow CURE Hospital, sponsoring Night to Shine, a nationwide prom for people with special needs, providing care for orphans in four countries and adoption aid grants for families who choose to adopt an international child with special needs.



# GOD IS ON THE MOVE!

"Go into all the world." Mark 15:16

It's amazing how much of the "world" has relocated right here in our very own backyard! With increased mobilization of our medical teams, we are truly on the move in so many new directions. Here are a few updates on the incredible work of our mobile unit team.

#### Refugees:

Noel, MO is home to refugees and immigrants from many different countries, as well as families whose ancestors are generational residents. We were recently invited to participate in a community wellness event in Noel, where our mobile unit team provided wellness screenings as well as information about our services in the Joplin and Carthage clinics. A young refugee man from Africa was recently reunited with his wife and was excited to know that when they start their family they can visit our clinics for their pregnancy test and ultrasound. Repeatedly, the team heard the words "thank you" in many languages, including: English, Spanish, Burmese, Sudanese and Somali.

#### Inmates:

When the Department of Health shared their growing concern regarding the syphilis epidemic in southwest Missouri, our team stepped up. Within a few days we had a plan to deploy a two-person team to a local jail every two weeks to provide testing to both male and female inmates. On one occasion, the young man being tested told his nurse, "I know you, you did an ultrasound for my baby-momma." A tender exchange about the need for this daddy to 'get things right' and get back to his newborn son led to prayer and the opportunity for ongoing encouragement in his life.

#### **Survivors:**

When area law enforcement is faced with cases involving victims of sexual exploitation, their call to LifeChoices initiates a high-speed response. Be that in the middle of the night with no notice at all or with a few days of planning, our team is ready to roll. As local members of RISE (a local coalition against trafficking), we serve as victim-advocates prepared with a go-bag of supplies and options for individualized safety plans, often coordinating travel for survivors needing to leave our community. At times this involves purchasing a bus ticket, providing private transportation, or quick mobilization in a private plane to whisk someone away to a safe place for long-term restoration and healing.

#### Legislators:

Our team's reputation to serve with innovative excellence has taken us into unexpected high places! As a result of our positive outcomes with domestic survivors of trafficking, our Executive Director, Karolyn Schrage, has been invited to serve on the Missouri Attorney General's Human Trafficking Task Force. Word of the collaborative efforts of LifeChoices with local, state, and federal law enforcement has resulted in frequent requests for interagency trainings across the nation!

For thirty years **God has been on the move** through the ministry and outreach of LifeChoices! We cannot wait to see what the next 30 years will hold!





# "JESUS DID THE REST."

The call came from a concerned parent; her daughter had given her a permission form from the school regarding the COMPASS sex education program. She was wary of someone teaching her daughter about such an important topic and she wanted more information and answers. This young mother shared that she hadn't always made the best choices when she was younger and she didn't want her daughter introduced to these intimate topics so young.

After a lengthy conversation on the phone with our Prevention Services Director, an invitation was extended for this mother to come into our office to review the curriculum and discuss all of her concerns at length. We are always encouraged when parents are so invested in their child's life that they choose to actively participate in the education we provide in 16 area school districts.





At the end of the visit, the mother decided to allow her daughter to participate in COMPASS. Before leaving she shared, "I've been here before as a client and everyone was really sweet. Mischa was my nurse and **she prayed for me before I even knew how to pray for myself**, and it eventually gave me the courage to make better choices and **Jesus did the rest.**"

From a patient in our clinic to the parent of a student in our school program – LifeChoices is leaving its mark on this family, and so many thousands of others. Thank you for your support of these important programs!
