"I DON'T KNOW IF I CAN DO THIS ANYMORE..."

For over three decades, LifeChoices has stood in the gap for the vulnerable in our community, sharing hope and healing through professional and compassionate healthcare with those who often desperately need it. In 2024, we provided over 1,600 free pregnancy tests and already this year we have seen a 56% increase in pregnancy clients.

Our clinic has also recently served a record number of women who are contemplating abortion decisions. With a new abortion clinic 35 minutes

outside the Joplin metro, coupled with the proliferation of websites that offer abortion pills by mail, women are now making abortion decisions quicker than ever, with limited or no physician oversight.

Our team is well-trained to provide advocacy, resources, ultrasounds, STI testing/ treatment, partner resources, adoption information, and more for these women. Additionally, our team discusses abortion pill reversal protocols and post-abortion care services should a client choose to terminate their pregnancy and then find themselves with physical, emotional, or spiritual needs that require additional care.

In the last three months, five women have contacted us about abortion pill reversal services. One of these encounters will stay with me forever...

"Hey, can I come see you tomorrow? I think something is wrong."

As I read these words, my heart sank.

I quickly scheduled her for another ultrasound appointment and was thankful she brought her boyfriend with her. They were young, barely making ends meet, and had no support from their families. He appeared to truly care about his girlfriend but lacked the tools needed to support her through this emotional process. The hope coupled with worry I saw on their faces during this ultrasound further deepened my own internal sadness.

As we diligently performed the ultrasound and quickly realized their baby no longer had a heartbeat, I thought to myself *"I don't know if I can do this anymore..."* I set my own emotions aside to provide this couple with the emotional and physical support they needed to manage this loss, but as we were processing as a team afterwards, my heart was encouraged by a teammate saying, *"What if our services help in some way with their own grief process? Isn't that still a win for the lives of that young couple?"*

Later that night, our client sent me another text saying, *"Thank you for the pregnancy loss gift.* We really appreciate it. And thank you for seeing me today. Thank you for everything."

Despite her heartbreaking loss, this client took the time to thank us and, in turn, encouraged our own breaking hearts. We desperately desire to provide care and compassion for couples who are facing one of the hardest decisions they may ever make. I am thankful this young woman knows that we care and that she is loved – despite the decisions she has made.

Thank you for standing alongside us in this important work. Your prayers and partnership give us the strength to continue offering love, grace, and hope to all we serve.

It was a cold winter day as our team prepared for the Arkansas Attorney General's *Operation Obscured Vision.* We were privileged to provide consultation to local service providers in the months leading up to this seven-city multidisciplinary operation against illicit massage businesses. Additionally, in collaboration with many other organizations, our team was able to respond with medical services and victim's support for potential trafficking survivors, utilizing our experience from **34 previous human trafficking operations.**

We are excited to report that 16 women received services from our team. Additionally, multiple arrests were made by law enforcement and ongoing investigations continue.

And, while the news headlines recount seizures of assets and arrests of criminals, **God used our team to help many of these victims realize that freedom was** *just one step away.* We know their journey will be long and their traumas won't be easily erased, but a pathway to healing is possible.

After spending several days at our Amani Landing respite center, one of the ladies shared, "Thank you very much for your meticulous care and letting me feel the warmth of family in a foreign country." When responding that the warmth she felt was God's love, she said, **"I think he (God) is as beautiful** as sunshine. There is love everywhere. I am very grateful to God for letting me meet you."

LifeChoices has had the privilege to access the hearts of **over 380 victims of human trafficking and exploitation** since 2016. Many of these are domestically trafficked women right here in our own backyards. For most, they don't realize there is a way out – no one has ever shared how their **next step** could be the **first step** towards a new life of freedom.

Thanks to a generous gift from a couple in our community, LifeChoices has implemented a new program called "Next Steps" to assist individuals stepping out of sexual exploitation or trafficking. When a gift is given towards this program, it is used to help survivors follow their dreams of higher education, trade school, job placement programs, etc. This couple has also kindly pledged to match any Next Steps gifts (up to \$20,000) with a gift towards our General Fund to keep our ongoing services available for those who need medical care, material resources, and pregnancy support. Your generosity towards this new program will have double the impact for our medical clinics and school programs, as well as helping expand services for survivors of exploitation and trafficking.

Already we've been able to provide **next step** tools to help several individuals see their dreams realized. For one, it was a new laptop to begin dental assistant school. For another, it helped with a utility bill so she could stay in school. And for yet another, it was car repairs so she could keep her new job. **While some of these steps may seem minor to us, for others these steps are a lifeline to freedom.**

- Sexual assault prevention
- Cyber safety
- Boundaries
- Consent
- Recognizing abuse and predatory behaviors
- Mental health
- Local resources for ongoing support

Our goal is to give students the confidence and knowledge to navigate life's challenges successfully.
